2015-16 are very special years for the CRPS community. In research, RSDSA is funding six active research projects:

- Our ongoing 20-year study of CRPS impact on the long-term health of people with CRPS,
- A two-and-a-half year study in Europe and North America to define recovery and the priorities for recovery from the perspectives of people with CRPS
- An international study to develop a CRPS severity score.
- Establishment and funding of an international research consortium to provide a unified and convergent direction and approach to basic and clinical research in CRPS (almost 45 labs are participating).
- A pilot study to treat CRPS with low-dose naltrexone at Stanford University
- An exploratory study of Genetic, Epigenetic, Proteomic, Metabolic, and Gene Expression related factors in CRPS at Vanderbilt University.
- A multi-site study of Sympathetically Maintained Pain in CRPS.
